Logan Andreyko Awarded the 2023 John L. Spalding Scholarship

(*Gaithersburg, MD*) — The Chairman’s Advisory Committee of the Education Market Association has selected Logan Andreyko as the 2023 [John L. Spalding Memorial Scholarship](#) winner. The scholarship of \$5,000 is awarded annually to a deserving student to be used for undergraduate education.



Logan was sponsored by Tammy Andreyko, Superintendent at the Quaker Valley School District, and a member of the EDmarket Education Council. He is a sophomore at Case Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio pursuing a double major in Finance and Economics.

In his winning essay Logan wrote, “I have a calling to help others achieve financial security and freedom, and my education will provide me with the tools and skillsets to make that dream become a reality.... With the help of this scholarship, my next two years of undergraduate studies could become much easier to finance and provide a bit of breathing room for my financial future after graduation and moving into my career.”

Since 1987, EDmarket has provided an annual college scholarship for its members and their children. This year, the scholarship amount was increased from \$2,500 to \$5,000, reflecting the steep rise in educational expenses. JLS scholarship applications are judged by the Chairman's Advisory Committee based on merit.
